empty and rinse

**Mixed Paper, Newspaper, Magazines, Boxes**  
empty and flatten

**No Plastic Bags**  
Do Not Bag Recyclables



**No Clothing or Linens**  
use donation programs



**No Hazardous Items**  
no propane tanks, batteries, sharps, or chemicals



**No Tangles**  
no hoses, wires, chains or electronics



**No Food or Liquid**  
empty all containers
